Cost: £420.00 per student or £210.00 for PP and FSM students

Deposit: £60.00 deposit can be paid via Parent Pay or £30.00 for FSM and PP students. Please only pay once you have been notified that your child has a place on the trip. Please look for item name: 'PGL Osmington Bay Residential 2023' on Parent Pay. All monies will need to be paid in advance of the trip by Friday 14th April, this can be paid by instalments or a one off lump sum.

The price includes accommodation, coach travel, three meals per day, all activities and specialist instructors and equipment. We believe this is real value for money.
